Whereas, a public emergency exists regarding COVID- 19 pandemic, and the Court needs to comply with Governor Inslee’s Emergency Order and Whereas Mayor Nehring issued an Emergency Declaration Closing all City buildings effective immediately and the Order 25700-8-602 issued by Chief Justice Debra Stephens,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1) Effective March 17, 2020, the Marysville Municipal Court building will be closed with the limited exception of in-custody cases. In-Custody calendar will proceed according to the normal and regular schedule.
- 2) The new procedures under this Emergency Administrative Order shall be in effect for the Marysville Municipal Court and shall remain in effect until March 31, 2020 or until rescinded or modified by the Marysville Municipal Court Presiding Judge.
- 3) All hearings currently scheduled and for hearings on new cases filed during this order shall be delayed or continued and shall constitute an excluded period pursuant to the authority granted in the Washington State Supreme Court emergency order 25700-B-602 granting emergency authority for courts to adopt, modify and suspend court rules and orders.
- 4) All hearings currently scheduled during the period of emergency court closure shall be continued to the next available court date. Notices will be mailed to the parties of the next scheduled hearing date via US mail.
- 5) The Court will resume regular operations no sooner than Wednesday, April 1, 2020.
- 6) This order may be modified or extended as circumstances require.
