Discussion Questions:

1. One of the themes of the film is that the truth about the history of race in United States' has often been hidden from us, but it's often been hidden in plain sight. Was there something in the film that was surprising to you? Is there something in the film that you were not aware of or learned for the first time?
2. The film makes a convincing and compelling case for the argument that the United States was founded on white supremacy. In particular, the film highlights the modern criminal justice systems roots in slave patrols and in its active maintenance of slavery and white supremacist paradigms, often by turning a blind eye to lynchings, massacres, and violence. What steps can we, as judges, take to disrupt this legacy and chart a new path for Courts in the criminal justice system?
3. Jeff Robinson has said that his film is an invitation for audiences "to have a naked lunch moment with me about race in America—a moment to look at what is on the end of our collective fork." What can DMCJA do to have a "naked lunch" moment and be part of charting a better, anti-racist future for Washington Courts?
