2014 Washington State High School Mock Trial

Champion: SEATTLE PREP

OLYMPIA—MARCH 30, 2014—Seattle Prep took top honors this Sunday as the 2014 champion of the statewide YMCA Mock Trial Competition. The team is now eligible to compete for the national Mock Trial title in Wisconsin in May.

Washington Supreme Court Justice Debra Stephens presided over the championship trial in Olympia between Archbishop Murphy of Snohomish County and Seattle Prep of King County competing for the statewide title.

Top ten finalists of the competition are as follows:

1st place: **Seattle Prep** 2nd place: **Archbishop Murphy**

3rd place: Kings High School 4th place: International Community School

5th place: **Port Townsend High School** 6th place: **Franklin High School**

7thplace: **Meridian High School** 8th place: **Kings High School** (2nd team)

9th place: **The River Academy** 10th place: **Tri-Cities Prep**

The Best Witness Award went to Zane Sharif from Camas High School, and the Best Attorney Awards went to Molly McCarthy and Katherine Gavin from Seattle Prep and Claudia Morales from Archbishop Murphy.

A total of 20 high school teams from across the state competed for the title in a three-day, four-round competition this weekend at the Thurston County Courthouse, as attorneys and witnesses in a fictitious criminal trial inspired by both an unfinished Charles Dickens novel and recent criminal cases around Washington.

This is the 27th year for the YMCA Mock Trial program, which began in 1987. Mock Trial is part of the YMCA's Youth & Government program, which helps students experience democracy in action. Mock Trial allows students to participate in true-to-life courtroom drama before real judges in real courtrooms, gaining an understanding of the law and the role of the judiciary.
