



More time to file request to reconsider charter court ruling

SEATTLE -

The Washington Supreme Court says it will allow more time to file a motion asking the justices to reconsider or clarify their ruling on charter schools.

Washington Attorney General Bob Ferguson said more than a week ago that his office will ask the court to reconsider its ruling.

The court decided on Sept. 4 that the voter-approved charter school law is unconstitutional.

The high court's opinion was set to take effect later this month, but will be put on hold until the court rules on the state's request for reconsideration. There is no timeline on when the court may rule on the request.

The new deadline for filing a request for reconsideration of the ruling is Oct. 23. The original deadline was this week.
