Re: ***Proposed change to RPC 1.15A***
Comment on recommended change

Dear Justices:

Our law firm is strongly in favor of the proposed change to RPC 1.15A which would restrict the annual reporting requirements for notifying clients of property held by an attorney or law firm applying only to "funds" held by the attorney for the client, and not other original documents such as wills and estate planning documents.

This is a welcome proposed change because our firm over the past 30 years has, at the client's request, held the original wills, powers of attorney and estate planning documents in our fire proof will safe at no additional cost to the clients. Over these many years we have accumulated over a thousand such documents. If we had to annually notify clients that we were holding their wills, etc. this would be an unreasonable burden and expense and mean we would no longer offer this service to clients.
