My name is Solinuu Leae. I am currently incarcerated at Green Hill School in Chehalis, Washington. Being shackled, I felt like I was being held captive and I had no control over myself. I got the chance to experience the life of a modern day slave. My name became another number and I was labeled as state property. I felt being shackled was unnecessary because I got escorted by 2 armed officers from the holding to the court room. I felt like they put shackles on me to make myself look less presentable and extremely dangerous. It gives me an image that isn't mine. When I first got sentenced for my charge there were news reporters with cameras recording live footage and taking pictures. I then felt even more violated and mistreated. It made everything the prosecutor said seem true. They called me a threat to the state, a menace to society and a high risk felon. It gives the prosecutors side a plus advantage to win another case.
