

RULE 7.
PLEADINGS ALLOWED; FORM OF MOTIONS.

(b) Motions and Other Papers.

(1) How Made.

(A) Reapplication on Same Facts. When an order has been applied for and refused in whole or in part or has been granted conditionally and the condition has not been performed, the same application for an order shall not be presented to another Judge without advising the second Judge of the fact that the order was previously refused or conditioned.

(B) Subsequent Motion, Different Facts. If a subsequent application is made upon an alleged different set of facts, it shall be shown by affidavit what application was made, when and to what Judge, what order or decision was made thereon, and what different facts are claimed to be shown. Any order obtained in violation of this section may be set aside.

(5) Telephonic Argument. Telephonic appearances are not allowed on motion docket calendars. All other requests for appearing at hearings by telephone for purposes of oral argument shall be approved by the Court and specially set by the Court Administrator.
