#### POSITION PROFILE

Administers the dissemination of electronic court records contained in the Judicial Information System (JIS) and serves as the staff attorney for the Judicial Information System Committee - Data Dissemination Committee.

Work is guided by court rules, case law and policies established by a committee staffed by the Data Dissemination Administrator. Communicates and assists the courts, state, local and federal agencies including the state legislature and legislative agencies in retrieving, disseminating, and interpreting electronic court data and metadata. Reviews requests for confidential data and ensures dissemination of such data is only to authorized authorities and personnel. Has up to \$25,000 signing authority on AOC contracts.

<u>Duties and Responsibilities</u> (partial list)
Assists the Contracts Manager with planning, organizing, and conducting the procurement and contracting activities of the Supreme Court, AOC, and other judicial branch entities as appropriate.

Develops, implements, maintains and monitors statewide policies, procedures and best practices for responding to court data dissemination requests.

Based on court rules, case law, state statutes, and statewide policy documents, reviews and approves or denies data dissemination requests from the public and private sector.

Serves as principal policy advisor to all judicial branch entities regarding release of statewide court data; develops statewide policy papers and recommendations to the Data Dissemination Committee.
