

Program Manager II (Problem Solving Court Manager) for Mason County. Serves under the authority of the Superior Court Judges as a managerial level position primarily responsible for a full range of programs and services for families and offenders in the community. Performs administrative, managerial, and supervisory work required in planning, delivery, and evaluation of services for the Dependency Family Recovery Court, Superior Court Adult Felony Court, and the Veteran's Services Track.

Minimum Requirements: Bachelor's degree from an accredited four-year college or university with major course work in psychology, sociology, or criminal justice with four years of progressively responsible experience working with child abuse/neglect, families and offenders, and program management. Experience in organization development and a minimum of two years supervisory experience. Knowledge of therapeutic Court components and protocol is preferred.
