- Decide who are the legal parents of a child.
- Decide the presumed parent is **not** the legal parent.
- Withdraw (rescind) the Paternity Acknowledgment
- Invalidate the Paternity Acknowledgment.
- Withdraw (rescind) the Denial of Paternity.
- Invalidate the Denial of Paternity.

Non-Parent Custody

- Give custody of the children to a non-parent.

You must respond in writing if you want the court to consider your side.

Deadline! Your *Response* must be **filed and served** within **90 days** of the date this summons is mailed. If you do not file and serve your *Response* or a *Notice of Appearance* by the deadline:

- No one has to notify you about other hearings in this case, and
- The court may approve the requests in the *Petition* without hearing your side (called a *default judgment*).
