RE: 2012 FALL SUMMARY OF CHANGES TO DOMESTIC RELATIONS

FORMS

The Washington Pattern Forms Committee updated the mandatory Domestic Relations pattern forms to implement Laws of 2012, ch. 3, Same Sex Marriage. Washington State voters approved Referendum 74 which approved this law. The new provisions go into effect December 6, 2012.

Following are detailed descriptions of the changes:

In paragraph 3.5, change the paragraph heading as follows:

"Liabilities to be Paid by the WifeRespondent"

Also in paragraph 3.5, change "wife" to "respondent" in the second through fourth check box options. In the sentence below the check box for "Other," change "wife" to "respondent" and change "her" to "the respondent."

In paragraph 3.7, in the second and fourth check box options, change "husband" to "petitioner" and "wife" to "respondent."

In paragraph 3.14, in the second check box option, change "wife" to 'respondent." In the third check box option, change "husband" to "petitioner."
