- SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF CHANGES TO VULNERABLE ADULT PROTECTION ORDER FORMS

The Pattern Forms Committee updated the mandatory Vulnerable Adult Protection Order forms, instructions, and clerk's staff handbook. The modifications are based upon Laws of 2012, ch. 156, Vulnerable Adult Protection Orders –Costs, and approved recommended changes. Detailed descriptions of the changes follow:

		Entry." In the paragraph below the new section heading "WACIC Data Entry," after the second check box, insert "City" before "Police Department Where Petitioner Lives"
		On page three, under the section heading " <b>Service</b> " below the check boxes, add the following sentence:
		"Service may be done by a law enforcement agency, free of charge, a hired professional process server, or a person 18 or over who is not a party to this action."

		On page three, directly above the paragraph that begins, "It is further ordered that the clerk of the court" insert

		and center the new section heading "WACIC Data Entry."
		In the paragraph below the new section heading "WACIC <b>Data Entry</b> ," after the second check box, insert "City" before "Police Department <i>Where Petitioner Lives</i> "
		Under the section heading " <b>Service</b> " below the check boxes, add the following sentence:
		"Service may be done by a law enforcement agency, free of charge, a hired professional process server, or a person 18 or over who is not a party to this action."

		On page one, in the sentence that begins "Service may be done by a" insert a colon after the word "a," add a paragraph return, and put the remainder of the sentence in bullet format, with the following changes:
		<ul> <li>"<u>L</u>!aw enforcement agency, <u>free of charge;</u></li> <li><u>a</u> <u>H</u>hired a professional process server; or</li> <li><u>a pP</u>erson 18 or over who is not a party to this action."</li> </ul>
		On page 6, above the section " <b>Law Enforcement</b> Information Sheet (LEIS)," insert the following new section:
		"Service of the Temporary Order
		Unless the respondent or the respondent's lawyer was present at the hearing, this order must be served on the respondent. The respondent must know what restraint provisions are in place, when and where the hearing will occur and when the order expires.
		If you filed on behalf of a vulnerable adult, unless the vulnerable adult or the vulnerable adult's lawyer was present at the hearing, this order must be served on the vulnerable adult. The vulnerable adult must know what

		<ul> <li>restraint provisions are in place, when and where the hearing will occur and when the order expires. You must also serve the vulnerable adult's guardian, if any.</li> <li>You may choose service by:</li> <li>A law enforcement agency, which will serve your papers free of charge.</li> <li>A hired professional process server.</li> <li>Another person 18 or over, who is not a party to this action.</li> <li>Mail or publication, if the judge previously entered an order allowing service by mail or publication.</li> <li>You will need to provide the address for each person to be served. On page two, below the definition of " <b>Exploitation</b> " add the following definition:
"Financial Exploitation
"Financial Exploitation" means the illegal or improper use, control over, or withholding of the property, income, resources, or trust funds of the vulnerable adult by any person, or entity for any person's or entity's profit or advantage other than for the vulnerable adult's profit or advantage. "Financial exploitation" includes, but is not limited to:
<ul> <li><u>The use of deception, intimidation, or undue</u> influence by a person or entity in a position of trust and confidence with a vulnerable adult to obtain or use the property income, resources, or trust funds of the vulnerable adult for the benefit of a person or entity other than the vulnerable adult;</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>The breach of a fiduciary duty, including, but not limited to, the misuse of a power of attorney, trust, or a guardianship appointment, that results in the unauthorized appropriation, sale, or transfer of the property, income, resources, or trust funds of the vulnerable adult for the benefit of a person or entity other than the vulnerable adult; or</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Obtaining or using a vulnerable adult's property, income, resources, or trust funds without lawful authority, by a person or entity who knows or clearly should know that the</li> </ul>

vulnerable adult lacks the capacity to consent to the release or use of his or her property, income, resources, or trust funds."
On page three, in the definition of " <b>Vulnerable Adult</b> " change the fourth bullet as follows:
<ul> <li>"Admitted to <u>any facility, including a</u> boarding home, nursing home, adult family home,"</li> </ul>
Also in the definition of " <b>Vulnerable Adult</b> ," insert the following as the fifth bullet:
<ul> <li>"<u>Receiving services from home health, hospice, or</u> <u>home care agencies licensed or required to be</u> <u>licensed under chapter 70.127 RCW; or</u>"</li> </ul>
Change the last definition of " <b>Vulnerable Adult</b> " as follows:
• "Who self-directs his or her own care and receives services from a personal aide under chapter 74.39 <u>RCW</u> Receiving services from a compensated personal aide who provides at home care for the vulnerable adult at his or her direction."
On page nine, in section " <b>2. How to Obtain a</b> <b>Vulnerable Adult Order for Protection</b> ," add the following sentence to the end of paragraph 1:
" <u>There is no cost for the forms.</u> "
On page 10, in paragraph 14, after the sentence "You will need to deliver the packet to the law enforcement agency," change the next sentence as follows:
"You may be required to pay the fees to serve <u>The</u> law enforcement agency will serve your papers free of charge."
Also on page 10, in paragraph 15, after the sentence "You will need to deliver the packet to the law enforcement agency." Change the next sentence as follows:

"You may be required to pay the fees to serve <u>The</u> law enforcement agency will serve your papers free of charge."
On page 12, in paragraph 23, after the sentence "The law enforcement agency where the respondent lives usually serves the respondent," change the next sentence as follows:
" <u>The law enforcement agency will serve your papers</u> free of chargeYou may be required to pay the fees to serve."
Also on page 12, in paragraph 25, after the sentence, "You will need to deliver the service packet to the law enforcement agency," change the next sentence as follows:
" <u>The law enforcement agency will serve your papers</u> free of chargeYou may be required to pay the fees to serve."
On page 14, below the title " <b>Persons Who Can Serve</b> <b>the Papers</b> ," in the paragraph that begins, "Typically, people want a law enforcement" change the last sentence as follows:
" <u>The law enforcement agency will serve your</u> papers free of chargeYou may need to pay the law enforcement service fee".
On page 15, below the title " <b>Cost of Service,</b> " change the second paragraph as follows:
"If law enforcement serves the papers, they <del>may</del> collect fees for service and mileage – these fees vary with each agencywill serve your papers free of charge."
On page 17, change the text of section "Forwarding Papers to Law Enforcement" as follows:
"If you want law enforcement to serve the papers on the respondent or on the vulnerable adult, if

<ul> <li>applicable, you will need to obtain copies of the papers from the court clerk and then you will need to personally deliver the papers to law enforcement. The law enforcement agency will serve your papers free of chargeThe law enforcement agency may require a service fee. You may need to make arrangements with the law enforcement agency to pay the fee before the agency attempts to serve the respondent or the vulnerable adult. On page 25, under " <b>Notice to the Vulnerable Adult</b> ," in the third line, change the word "additional" to "addition."
In page 27, under " <b>Vulnerable Adult</b> :" in (d) after the word "to" and before the letter "a", add " <u>any facility, including</u> "
Add a new "(e)" as follows:
"(e) receiving services from home health, hospice, or home care agencies licensed or required to be licensed under chapter 70.127 RCW; or"
Change the former "( $e$ )" to "( $\underline{f}$ )."
Change the former "(f)" to "(g)" and change "(g)" as follows:
"(g) who self-directs his or her own care and receives services from a personal aide under chapter 74.39 <u>RCW.</u> receiving services from a compensated personal aide who provides at home care for the vulnerable adult at his or her direction."
