

## Felony Judgement and Sentence Summary of Changes

## Form Changes related to legislation

1. CrR4.2(g) Statement of Defendant upon Plea of Guilty (Sex and Non-Sex)

Changed the voter advisement to "I will be ineligible to register to vote until that right is restored in a manner provided by law. My right to vote is automatically restored as long as I am not serving a sentence of total confinement (as defined in RCW 29A.08.520) under the jurisdiction of the Department of Corrections and not incarcerated for a felony conviction in federal court or any state court other than Washington. If I am sentenced to total confinement under the jurisdiction of the Department of Corrections or otherwise incarcerated as described in this subsection, my voter registration will be cancelled." to reflect changes made to RCW 29A.08.520 by HB 1078 (2021).

<u>Removed</u> a statutory reference related to violating the term of a Domestic Violence Protection Order.

<u>Changed</u> a Statutory reference in that same section to comply with recodification due to HB 1320 (2021).

Added in a manner that endangered persons or property to the warning that a defendant's driver license will be revoke if a vehicle was used during the commission of a felony.
