The court finds that respondent has timely and completely surrendered all firearms in the respondent's custody, control, or possession and any concealed pistol license to a law enforcement agency and is in compliance with this order pursuant to RCW 7.105.340(6). Added a checkbox to the, "Respondent: You must attend the hearing listed on page 1" sentence.  (3) Updated the footer with new publication date.
