The table below outlines changes to the Extreme Risk Protection Order forms based on Laws of 2023, ch. 320 (<u>ESSB 5231</u>) and comments.

	Form Number & Title	Description of Changes
1.	XR 101 & 201 Petition for ERPO	Changes:  (1) In 1, added "For Emergency Domestic Violence ERPO: (victim name) [ ] has consented to an emergency domestic violence extreme risk protection order [ ] is incapacitated."  (2) In footer, added citation, corrected existing citation, and updated publication date.
2.	XR 121 & 221 Temporary ERPO	Changes:  (1) In 5, added "[ ] Personal Service Required. The court has not verified that all firearms and any concealed pistol license have been temporarily removed by law enforcement."  (2) Above immunity language, added "This order may be extended pursuant to RCW 10.99.040(3)."  (3) In footer, added citation and updated publication date.
3.	XR 112 Proof of Service	Changes:  (1) In 2, "Important!" box, added "For a domestic violence ERPO, electronic service is only available after the court verifies that firearms have been surrendered."  (2) In 5, added additional lines and "(include details such as conduct at time of service, threats, avoidance of service, and statements regarding firearms possession)."  (3) In footer, updated citation and publication date.
