**RE:** Summary of Changes for Protection Order Forms (July 2023)

The table below outlines changes to the Protection Order forms based on Laws of 2023, ch. 462 (<u>E2SHB 1715</u>), Laws of 2023, ch. 320 (<u>ESSB 5231</u>), GR 22, *State v. Flannery*, 24 Wash. App. 2d 466, 520 P.3d 517 (2022), and comments.
