

The Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) released an RFP on April 29, 2011 soliciting Proposals from qualified Vendors to provide professional services to design and implement a Superior Court Data Exchange (SCDX) that will enable the real-time exchange of data between the AOC's Judicial Information System (JIS) applications and local Superior Court systems; and other Justice Partners.

**The AOC has decided to extend the Proposal due date by 2 weeks. Proposals are now due by June 6, 2011, 9am. The AOC will also respond to additional RFP questions, if the Vendor questions are submitted by May 17, 9am.**

These changes supersede the schedule documented in the RFP. All Vendor questions submitted to the AOC by May 9, 9am, will be answered within the next couple of days.
