AMENDMENT 1

This is an amendment to ACQ-2013-0515-RFQQ issued by the Administrative Office of the Courts on July 16, 2013 for Information Services Division's Data Strategy Consulting Services.

This RFQQ is amended as follows:

RFQQ Section 4.5 – RELEVANT EXPERIENCE is hereby amended to add the following:

For each of the items listed below, Vendor must describe the relevant experience for the proposed Data Strategy Consultant. Clearly identify how the Data Strategy Consultant possesses the relevant experience. Specifics as to number of years, number of implementations, etc. should be provided. Limit responses to each item to 150 words for the proposed Data Strategy Consultant.

- 1) Expert Architect experience with data integration solutions, strategies and best practices.
- 2) Proven ability to provide schedule inputs, budgetary inputs, technical, and risk realities into data integration implementation projects such that actual results were forecasted and understood by the management.
- 3) Development of master data design, data models, schemas, and access business rules.
- 4) Consultative leadership of the creation of standards, guidelines, policies and processes for Master Data Governance, convergence and synchronization.
- 5) Consultative leadership to establish Data Governance organization, roles and responsibilities in a complex business environment.
- 6) Consultative approach to applying technical leadership, identifying and resolving complex data integration issues.
- 7) Oral and written communication that effectively conveys complex technical issues and resolution to both technical and non-technical audiences, as well as to the broad range of stakeholders among the justice community, vendors, and senior management and staff.
- 8) Business process design for managing Master Data throughout the lifecycle, including data quality, metadata and workflow technologies.
- 9) Implementing data integration solutions in a federated database environment.
- 10) Evaluation, selection and implementation of data integration tools with other systems specifying which tools have been used.
- 11) ETL, middleware and messaging technologies specifying which tools have been used.
