RE: VACANCY ON COURT INTERPRETER COMMISSION

The Washington State Court Interpreter Commission develops policies governing the Washington State Court Interpreter Program. All court interpreters who are and seek to become certified or registered by the Washington Administrative Office of the Courts are subject to rules and regulations specified by policies set by the Commission. The Washington State Supreme Court selects members to represent various constituent groups in the court and interpreter communities. Each member is expected to share current information with the constituent groups they represent as well as bring current issues to the Commission for consideration.

The term for one of our current interpreter representatives expires on September 30, 2012 and the Interpreter Commission is soliciting applications from court interpreters interested in filling this vacancy. The Commission typically meets quarterly, and sub-committees meet telephonically on a bimonthly basis. There is no compensation paid to Commission members, but reimbursement of travel expenses is available for participation pursuant to government guidelines.
