# SC-CMS: A Partnership with the Court Community

## A Modern Case Management System

The term “SC-CMS” is short for the Superior Court Case Management System Project. This project is intended to acquire and implement a centrally hosted commercial off-the-shelf (COTS) case management system. Once acquired and implemented, the system will be made available to superior courts statewide.

## Partnering with the Court Community

The current Superior Court Management Information System (SCOMIS) is 35 years old. Business and technology needs have evolved considerably since that time.

SCOMIS is difficult to change, costly to maintain, and has limited ability to integrate with some newer, innovative applications. Therefore, AOC is partnering with the court community to acquire a system that will provide adequate support for current and future superior court needs.


## Superior Court Benefits

The modern technology of the new case management system will enhance the ability of the Superior courts to:

- Efficiently direct and monitor court case progress;
- Schedule case events;
- Enforce court business rules;
- View case schedules, status, progress, and case party information; and
- Communicate court schedules and orders.

## Project Timeline

The high-level SC-CMS Project timeline is outlined below. This timeline will be adjusted when contract negotiations with the Apparent Successful Vendor are complete.



## System Implementation

The SC-CMS Project Team expects to implement the software in a pilot court starting in February 2015. Statewide rollout is planned to start in August 2015 and run through August 2018.

AOC staff will partner with court representatives throughout the project to ensure each court is appropriately prepared for the new system.
