#### II. Allegations

- **2.1** The youth is eligible for extended foster care services because the youth is 18 years or older but younger than 21 years old and agrees to participate in extended foster care.
- **2.2** [] Although not required in order to be eligible for the extended foster care program, the youth meets the educational or employment conditions, under 42 U.S.C. § 675(8)(B), because the youth is:

- [] enrolled and participating in a postsecondary academic or vocational education program or has applied for and demonstrated that they intend to timely enroll in a postsecondary academic or vocational program:
