Order Extending Order to Surrender and Prohibit Weapons

1. Extension

A temporary *Order to Surrender and Prohibit Weapons* was issued on (date) _____.

4. Warnings!

- If you fail to comply with the extended *Order to Surrender and Prohibit Weapons*, you may be found in contempt of court and/or be charged with a misdemeanor and punished accordingly.
- You may also be charged with a crime up to and including a **felony** if you are found to own, possess, or control a firearm or other dangerous weapon.
- You have the right to remain silent and not make statements that may incriminate you. Anything you say can be used against you in a court of law. You have the right to consult with a lawyer before responding to this Order.

5. Protection against self-incrimination

Voluntarily surrendering weapons may not be used against a Restrained Person in any criminal prosecution under chapter 7.105, 9.41, or 9A.56.310 RCW, or in any criminal prosecution pursuant to which this *Order to Surrender and Prohibit Weapons* was issued, except a prosecution for perjury, giving false statement, or otherwise failing to comply with the order.
