RE: 2012 SUMMARY OF CHANGES TO DOMESTIC RELATIONS FORMS

The Pattern Forms Committee updated the mandatory Domestic Relations pattern forms to implement:

- Laws of 2012, ch. 24, Service Members Civil Relief Act, effective on June 7, 2012,
- Improvements relating to the Uniform Parentage Act, Laws of 2011, ch. 283,
- Improvements recommended by the legal community.
