SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF CHANGES TO DOMESTIC VIOLENCE FORMS

The Pattern Forms Committee updated the mandatory Domestic Violence forms. The modifications are based upon approved changes recommended by the legal community. Detailed descriptions of the changes follow:

No.	Form No.	Title and description of changes
1.	WPF DV1.015	Petition for Order for Protection
		On page four, the first paragraph after " <i>Statement</i> " make the following changes:
		"Describe the most recent incident violent act, fear or threat of violence, and why the temporary order should be entered today without notice to the respondent date:"
2.	WPF DV3.015	Order for Protection
		On page three, change paragraph 11, as follows: "Petitioner is granted judgment against respondent <u>as provided in the Judgment, WPF</u> <u>DV 3.030.</u> for \$ fees and costs."
		On page four, directly above the paragraph that begins, "It is further ordered that the clerk of the court" insert and center the new section heading "WACIC Data Entry."
		On page four, in the paragraph below the new section heading "WACIC Data Entry," after the second check box, insert "City" before "Police Department Where Petitioner Lives"

		In the first check box option under " <b>Service</b> " after the second sub-check box insert "City" before "Police Department <i>Where Petitioner Lives</i> "
3.	WPF DV4.030	Petition for Surrender of Weapon
		In the caption, within the parentheses, delete "/ORH" as follows: "(PT <del>/ORH</del> )," and delete " <del>Clerk's Action Required</del> "
		Change paragraph 1, as follows:
		"I am the <u>petitioner in this action.</u> " "☐ Petitioner ☐ Respondent in this action."
		Change paragraph 2, as follows:
		"The <u>Respondent has: other party has:</u> (check all that apply)
		<ul> <li>Uused, displayed, or threatened to use a firearm or other dangerous weapon in a felony.</li> <li>Describe this offense:</li> </ul>
		Ppreviously committed an offense that makes him or her ineligible to possess a firearm under the provisions of RCW 9.41.040. Describe this offense:
		☐ That respondent's Possession of a firearm or other dangerous weapon <u>which</u> presents a serious and imminent threat to public health or safety, or to the health or safety of any individual. My concern for imminent threat is based on the following:"

4.	WPF DV4.035	Temporary Order to Surrender and Notice of Hearing
		This is a new form.
5.	WPF DV4.040	Order to Surrender Weapon
		This order was substantially revised. Please delete the prior version of WPF DV4.040 and replace it with the new version.

6.	DV7.070	Order re Adequate Cause (Respondent's Motion to Modify/Terminate Order for Protection Effective More Than Two Years)
		On page two, in the box titled " <b>Service</b> ," change the first check box option, as follows:
		"□ The clerk of court shall <del>also</del> forward a copy of this order on or before the next judicial day to:
		County Sheriff's Office <u>City</u> Police Department where the petitioner lives which shall personally serve (name) petitioner with a copy of this order and shall promptly complete and file proof of service with this court.
