RE: Changes to the No Contact Order forms and New Weapons Surrender forms

The Washington Pattern Forms Committee adopted the following Weapons Surrender and No Contact Order forms to address the change in the law ([HB 1320](#) and [HB 1901](#)). A majority of these forms are all new and the effective and revision date is 07/2022. Changes to the updated forms are below as well.

The previous criminal and civil weapons surrender forms and the no contact Orders will be removed from the [Administrative Office of the Courts' forms site](#) at the end of June. Updates will be made to No Contact Order forms at that time.
