- **RE:** SUMMARY OF CHANGES FOR MISDEMEANOR JUDGMENT AND SENTENCING FORMS (JUNE 2022)

The Washington Pattern Forms Committee updated the <u>misdemeanor judgment and</u> <u>sentencing court pattern forms</u>. These forms are effective June 9, 2022. We incorporated newly passed legislation, improved form accuracy, addressed user feedback, and increased clarity of information contained in these forms. In addition, we continue efforts to standardize our forms amongst all our form sets, and therefore, you will notice stylistic changes as well. The forms mentioned below are effective as of June 9, 2022.

A high-level overview of the form changes is provided in the table below, followed by a detailed summary of changes.

Clerk's Action. The clerk shall forward a Notice of Revocation of Concealed Pistol License to the Department of Licensing (DOL).

Clerk's Action. The clerk shall forward an Abstract of Court Record (ACR) to the DOL, which must revoke the **defendant's** driver's license. RCW 46.20.265.
