RE: Surrender of Weapons Forms Summary of Changes (July 2023)

The table below outlines changes to the Surrender of Weapons forms based on chapter 7.105 RCW, Laws of 2023, ch. 462 (E2SHB 1715), Laws of 2023, ch. 320 (ESSB 5231), GR 22, *State v. Flannery*, 24 Wash. App. 2d 466, 520 P.3d 517 (2022), and comments.

(3) In third bullet, added "while the Order to Surrender and Prohibit Weapons is in effect" for clarity. (4) In footer, updated publication date and form name.
