RE: Summary of Changes to Extreme Risk Protection Order Forms (July 2022)

The table below outlines the changes to the Extreme Risk Protection Order forms based on [Laws of 2021, ch. 215 \(E2SHB 1320\)](#), [Laws of 2022, ch. 268 \(SHB 1901\)](#), and [Laws of 2022, ch. 231 \(5628\)](#).
