RE: Summary of Changes for Extreme Risk Protection Order Forms (June 2024)

The table below outlines changes to the Extreme Risk Protection Order forms based on chapter 7.105 RCW and comments. Additional changes were made to improve clarity and accuracy of the forms.

1.	XR 102 Firearm Identification Worksheet	<p>Changes: (1) Throughout form, change “unknown” to “I don’t know” to be consistent with PO 001 Attachment E. Firearms Identification. (2) In 1, add check boxes before “own” and “have access to” to be consistent with Attachment E. (3) In 1, add “Explain how they may have access _____” based on law enforcement feedback. (4) Create new 2, moving and rewording question 9 about parts of firearms: “Does the restrained person purchase, own, or have access to parts that could be assembled into a working firearm (example: ghost guns)? [] Yes [] No [] I don’t know” to be consistent with Attachment E. Renumber remaining sections. (5) In 7, replace “On a scale from 1 to 5 (1 being “not very important and 5 being “very important)” with “How important are the firearms to the restrained person?” and add “(not very important),” “(very important),” and “[] I don’t know” to the numbers to be consistent with Attachment E. (6) In 8, add, “if known” to be consistent with Attachment E. (7) Delete old question 9 (reworded above as 2). (8) Below 10, remove instructions to circle and replace with “check.” Replace “your partner” language with “the restrained person.” (9) Below 10, replace existing firearms photo grid with grid from Attachment E. Add additional photo of handgun in holster based on law enforcement feedback. (10) In footer, update publication date.</p>
