Commissioner Motion Oral Argument Protocols and Additional Information

Division II is currently conducting in-person hearings in the courtroom. The courtroom is located at 909 A Street on the main lobby level. ADA access is available from the visitor parking level (P1) of the building.

Commissioner oral argument on motions for discretionary review and motions for accelerated review is limited to ten (10) minutes per side unless a motion for additional time is granted.

Counsel/pro se litigants must notify the Court Clerk's Office if they wish to make their oral arguments virtually rather than in a courtroom hearing. Counsel/litigants have five days from the date of the setting letter or notice of oral argument to make a request to appear virtually.

If you are feeling ill on the day of your scheduled argument, or if you have had a recent positive COVID-19 test, please follow Washington State Department of Health guidance and move to postpone oral argument or contact the clerk's office to arrange to appear remotely if the guidance states that you should isolate. For oral arguments on motions, if one participant in a case requests to appear virtually, then all participants in that case and the Commissioner will appear virtually, and no in-person hearing will be conducted.

Participants should arrive early to go through security, check in with the bailiff for further instructions, and to familiarize themselves with the courtroom. If you would like the Commissioner to be aware of a pronoun for a person presenting argument or a party, please share this information with the bailiff.
