I, Georgy Zaitloky, have received and reviewed the opening brief prepared by my attorney. Summarized below are the additional grounds for review that are not addressed in that brief. Ms. Lawry worked very hard on my behalf, but her time and budget was extremely limited. We did not have time to communicate. We had only a few very short (few minutes) meetings. When I told her about documents, pictures, videos, and other evidence supporting me and directly contradicting the charges and testimonies against me, she told me she could only get those if some one would pay her. When I asked her to give me my son's testimony from the discovery, Ms. Lawry said she couldn't give it to me because then she could not negotiate with me.

Among the documents I talked about was:

- My health record: Ms. Kim (the prosecutor) talked about the nature of my sickness and the tumor diagnosis several times during the trial, suggesting that I was not telling the truth. Verbatim report: pages 533-13 (me), 526-6 (me), 590-3 (Ms. Kim), 590-6 (me), 590-11 (Ms. Kim), 590-14 (me), 654-14 (Ms. Kim), 654-18 (me), 654-23 (Ms. Kim), 655-2 (me), 704-5~11 (Ms. Kim), 704-20~706-8 (Ms. Kim). Here I have attached a copy of my diagnosis.
- The medical records of Klara, my wife: This shows the numerous injuries she had when she was kicking and hitting furniture, drawers, counters when she was drinking.
- Interview with Dave Gerthes, the friend we went to the kayak tour with, and pictures of the trip would prove we were not fighting. It was a happy trip and we got banged up on the trip.
- The hours of video I made of Klara windsurfing and falling and hitting the equipment and rocks. Sometimes she was screaming in pain. The bruises from kayaking and windsurfing are talked about through the trial. Klara's testimony was that I caused these injuries.
- The gas station video where she bought cigarettes the night of June 26, 2014. It shows that she was drunk but not injured.
- The interview with our neighbors: They heard Klara yelling at me numerous times.
- Klara's contradicting, discrediting statements in the discovery documents. She told our daughter and our friend Gerrie that I did not abuse her physically but in her written statement of the court, she stated that I headbutted her every day and behaved very violently and aggressively with her.
- Klara also stated that because I broke her hand she was not able to shift the car into gear, walked to work on June 28. On a different page, the document states that she drove down to Morton to visit her friend that same day she supposedly could not drive. The journey to Morton is 200 miles round trip through winding mountain roads.

Ms. Lawry showed her helpfulness when she told me about two months ago that errors and mistakes from the trial were in the documents but she didn't have time to show me. She told me that I was intelligent and could find them myself. She also helped me out in the divorce court when she happened to be there.

Ms. Lawry did not have the resources to represent me effectively. I know she tried hard. Every word I said is the truth, but I could not access the supporting documents, pictures, videos, and accounts to prove this to the courts. The jury did not hear this and much more information. I could not defend myself adequately. I could not have a fair trial with an effective council provided by the Sixth Amendment of the United States Constitution.

The police arrested me on the night of July 8, 2013 only on the testimony of Klara. There was no interview or investigation. If there had been an investigation, they would have found:

- Klara's medical bills and doctor visit record were in the cabinet from her previous self-inflicted injuries.
- On my phone there were message from Klara from June 30 ~ July 3 that she would drive to Chelan to join me and we would go to our friend's party.
 - That she would drive to Chelan and pick me up because my van broke down.

- On July 3, she left a message that she was angry because I talked with her doctor, Dr. Jacob, from the cancer clinic. She had been drinking.
- There were damages on the washing machine from her kicking it and also on the front door. She kicked the door in when she could not find her key. These happened on nights when she was drinking.
- On the computer, my letter to my sister, talking about our marital problems.
- My diary of Klara's fights and provocations.
- The anti-depressant and nerve pain pills that Klara did not take.

I was arrested so suddenly that I did not even have time to put on socks. I was handcuffed and led to the police car. I was told that I broke Klara's hand. Following this, every court document was based on this police report.

Gyorgy Zatlóka has been my patient since 9/29/14. As part of my efforts to care for him, I have evaluated records regarding his history of thyroid illness. These records include clinic notes from Virginia Mason dated 2/17/2011 by Dr. Lee and 12/22/11 by Dr. Williams which describe evaluation for abnormal thyroid function tests and symptoms consistent w/ hyperthyroidism in late 2010. Per these notes, diagnoses considered at the time included a TSH producing pituitary adenoma and thyroid hormone resistance.

Patient gives a history of having hyperthyroidism on PTU for 15 years until discontinued in 2003. TFT reportedly normalize at that time until he started to have symptoms of palpitation, weight loss, hyperdefecation, joint pain and memory loss started to get worse since 9/2010. FT4 initially was slightly elevated with inappropriately normal TSH (1.25). The thought was TSH that is not suppressible could be due to either **TSH secreting pituitary tumor or thyroid hormone resistance syndrome**- both of which are extremely uncommon conditions. The very low uptake(3.3 %) on recent thyroid uptake and scan goes against thyroid hormone overproduction such as Grave's disease or toxic nodule.

He is feeling much better overall except he still has nervousness. He is not requiring to take much of the propranolol. Thyroid autoimmune antibodies such as TSI, Anti-TPO, Anti-TG antibodies are negative. TSH receptor antibodies is slightly elevated at 12 (normal <10). TFT were normal in 12/2010 as well as recently couple of weeks ago.
