## Ground # 1

First of all, I want the Court to know that I, Jeremiah Ray Anglin, am innocent of the charge of burglary. A mistake was made by the Cowlitz County Justice System in this case when they convicted and sentenced me for a crime I was truly innocent of.

I appreciate my Appellate Attorneys efforts and the strength of the issue of an impermissively suggestive line-up procedure she presents. I believe should be enough on its own to overturn this conviction, by any reasonable standard.

But, I also believe there to be ineffective assistance of Counsel issues inherent that did have an overall effect and did contribute significantly to a fundamental deprivation of my right to a fair trial.

When my trial attorney, Thad E. Scudder, advised me to not take the stand, in my own defense, and further when he advised me to "just take a bench trial" (as opposed to a jury trial), I do not believe he acted on my behalf with reasonable diligence, and these were not sound trial strategy(s) - not by any reasonable and objective measure.

I trusted Mr. Scudder to diligently look out for my interests here in this, and I don't feel that he did - how else could I get found guilty of something I did not do?

I freely admitted to those charges I was guilty of, but as to the burglary charge, as I told Mr. Scudder, I could never plead guilty to something I did not do and that is why I took this separate (burglary) charge to trial!

I did not know it at the time (of trial), I am not a lawyer, but in view of all the overall circumstances it made absolutely no sense what-so-ever for my (supposed) defense attorney to recommend a "Bench trial" and then recommend that I not take the stand in my own defense! This case needed to go before a jury. Period. And, in the case of a bench trial, at the very least, the judge needed to hear my side of the story! By any reasonable standard, the defense (trial attorney's) actions in this case can only be considered a "poor trial strategy" and an overall deficient performance of what one should reasonably expect of a trial defense attorney.

On top of all this, the trial attorney failed to do any investigation into my case (to prepare for a proper defense) at all!

I would ask the Court to take a careful, objective look at the overall record of this case presented, and at the issues presented by my Appeal Attorney and myself.

In Closing, I pray the Court will agree, based on the overall record presented, that I was fundamentally deprived of a Constitutional right to a fair trial, and now ask that this faulty conviction be set aside and either be remanded for a jury trial, or in the alternative dismissed with prejudice, in the interests of justice. Thus Appellant respectfully presents.


