Additional Ground 1

If indeed the court erred in allowing me to be convicted of
Count IV ~~Arson~~ because of insufficient evidence, then in the same
aspect, I should not have been convicted of 1st degree Arson, but
a lesser Arson charge. Reason being, Arson 1, in my case, was charged
because of the Attempt on collecting insurance proceeds. But if there wasnt
a conspiracy (Count IV) then there was not enough evidence to prove an attempt
to collect insurance.
