State v. Rodriguez, 288 Neb. 878, 891-92, __N.W.2d__ (Neb. 2014) ("the fact that the reported crime was seen as ongoing was critical to the outcome in Navarette v. California, —U.S.—, 134 S.Ct. 1683, 188 L.Ed.2d 680 (2014)"; trial court erred in determining there was reasonable suspicion to justify the traffic stop where the fact that officer "saw no one at the location where the caller reported having been thrown from a vehicle created doubt as to the anonymous caller's reliability. Furthermore, the caller did not report an ongoing crime, which under Navarette and other case law is necessary to support the finding of reasonable suspicion justifying a traffic stop.").
