NOTICE RE

SUPPLEMENTAL
INFORMATION

Appellant Darlene Brown has notified the Department of Commerce and wishes to apprise the Court that on May 27, 2015 her loan servicer, M&T Bank, offered her a Trial Payment Plan (TPP) toward a Freddie Mac loan modification. This TPP followed the initiation of a judicial foreclosure, which cannot proceed while Ms. Brown is in compliance with the TPP. The TPP requires Ms. Brown to make at least three monthly modified payments on her mortgage, beginning in July 2015. Ms. Brown intends to successfully complete the TPP requirements and hopes this will result in a permanent loan modification in October of




this year or thereafter that will enable her to keep her home and dispose of the foreclosure. However, even if Ms. Brown successfully completes the TPP and is granted a permanent modification, it is possible that she will face the need for foreclosure mediation in the future. Ms. Brown therefore maintains her request for declaratory relief through a ruling that Commerce's decision to deny her access to FFA mediation was based on its erroneous interpretation of the FFA, but at this time withdraws her request for an order requiring Commerce to allow her to engage in FFA mediation (Prayer for Relief ¶ 7 in the Amended Petition for Declaratory and Injunctive Relief).





