Disclosure Comm'n*, 96 Wn.2d 135, 634 P.2d 303 (1981) (while I-276 conferred subpoena power on Commission to compel production of information necessary to carry out its purposes, it did not specifically give the Commission power to compel production of lobbyist records, and Court quashed subpoena);


