I.

Identity of respondent

John Garrett Smith, respondent Pro Se, does hereby come before the Supreme Court of Washington in good faith.

II.

Decision of Court of Appeals

On October 4th, 2016, the Court of Appeal, Division II, ruled unanimously to reverse the conviction of the respondent for Second Degree Attempted Murder due to a privacy law violation in the acquisition of the singular piece of evidence used to charge and convict the respondent. In their decision, the Court of Appeals concurred with the determination of the trial court that the voice recording was inadvertent (Finding of Fact 3), and therefore, lacked the consent requisite for admissibility under RCW 9.73.030. The trial court ruled that due to the inadvertency, the recording was therefore neither a “recording”, “conversation”, “communication”, or “private”, and therefore not protected by the privacy act (RP 2A, 168, 11-12).

On these issues, the Court of Appeals ruled in opposition, and due to the divulgence of a private conversation, stored on a private communication device (a privately owned cellular phone), the recording was therefore inadmissible. The Court of Appeals ruled that the communication was 1) a “recording” (I.3, C, page 11) on a private device, 2) a “conversation” (I.3, A, page 9), and 3) “private” (I.3, B, page 9), with

4) no concession of privacy due to the nature or inadvertency of the recording (I.3, B, page 10), so therefore 5) the privacy against “divulgence” without consent per RCW 9.73.030(b) was violated (I.3, C, page 11 and page 12), 6) rendering the information inadmissible per 9.73.050. In order to acknowledge the entire Statute, the Court of Appeals substantiated the “recording” status by identifying a quote “recorder”, namely the defendant who called the phone in the search for it.

The Court of Appeals ruled that, A) there is no question that a cellular phone is an electronic device designed to record or transmit communications, B) that there is no question that a private communication was recorded by the respondent’s cellular phone, C) that neither party consented to the recording, and so, D) the recording was protected under RCW 9.73.030, US Constitution, Amendment 4, Washington Constitution, Article 1, Section 7, and therefore inadmissible as evidence under RCW 9.73.050. The Court of Appeal ruled correctly and their reversal warrants confirmation.

III.

Most poignant issue of the case

In their 11/3/16 motion for reconsideration, the State asks three questions that are addressed within this reply. Four years after an alleged

crime, the respondent, in echo of myriad prior formal requests, is still asking just one:

“Is a falsely manufactured and digitally synthesized recording, ostensibly abstracted from a private mobile phone, seized without a warrant by law enforcement at least 38 minutes before the alleged recording was made, legitimate (let alone admissible) as evidence under any law, especially to State and Federal privacy acts, and 4th and 14th Amendment due process safeguards?”

Of course, the answer is “no”.

The appropriate next question then can only be: “In light of such an unconscionable scheme, conducted with full scienter, that clearly and convincingly constitutes a fraud” (Miller v. Nelms 966 So. 2d 437 Florida District Court of Appeals II 2007), which is irrefutably demonstrated (again) herein, must not the following trio of logical assertions be manifest?

1. “Res judicata applies to actions to void judgments for fraud” - Baldwin, 287 US 156 (1932)
2. “If the judgment is void, the court must... vacate it” - Wright v. Miller, Federal Practice and Procedure, Civil Section 2862
3. Because this case is void ab initio on at least three counts of fraud upon the court specific to the matter of the alleged voice

recording, this case must be vitiated without delay in accordance with Washington Constitution, Article 1, Section 10.

“In holding that the due process clause bars police procedure which violates the basic notions of our accusatorial mode of prosecuting crime, in vitiates a conviction based on the fruits of such procedure, we apply the due process clause to its historic function of assuring appropriate procedure before liberty is curtailed or life is taken.... The history of our criminal law proves overwhelmingly that brutal methods of law enforcement are essentially self-defeating.” Sir Leon Radzinowicz, A History of English Law and its Administration from 1750, Vol. III (1948).

IV.

Response to issues presented

The documented questions raised by petitioner appear reasonable at first glance. The privacy acts are seminal to the law and order of American society. Ironically, the prosecution’s present and ongoing effort to weigh this case down in the minutia of the privacy act is an igneus fatui diversion from the underlying crimes that continue to cover up the facts of this case. Law cannot exist in a vacuum. Any attempt to establish precedent on a stalking horse cannot produce a valid result, especially in light of the fully documented fraud (see SAG 9/28/15, CrR 7.8 Motion 11/30/15, and section VII of this brief) that has permeated

this case from even before the time when the alleged assault occurred and the voice recording. The State's argument remains deceptive, at best:

1. Was the communication a "private conversation"?

The missing, and most vital comment in this question is in regard to the most dominant aspect of what is irrefutably a conversation: The male attempts to locate his phone a dozen or more times. In this case, the subject iPhone had actually been seized and entered into evidence by the VPD 38 minutes before the alleged recording was created. The inclusion of this most salient point (which reveals how the expectation of privacy of the male was violated) renders the description of issue number one proffered by the State deceptively incomplete.

The trial court's conviction was based on the premise that the recording was neither "private" nor "a conversation" on account of the inadvertency that the State argued at trial. The COA II held privacy of a conversation as protected, especially in light of the inadvertency i.e. it was non-consensual. Since the inadmissible evidence is herein shown to be four times the fruit of a poisonous tree, does the State deserve a second bite of the apple? The answer must be "no."

2. Is consent implied for an inadvertent recording?

The State circumvents the trial court's basis for conviction in this case: Their premise that because the alleged voicemail was inadvertent,

it was therefore not necessary to establish consent of any party. Will the Washington Supreme Court allow the State to deliberate the idea of implied consent of an invalid recording, that they once fought so hard to claim was unintended, in order to bypass the myriad rudimentary tenants of “private”, “conversation”, “communication”, “electronically stored”, “divulged”, etc.? The answer, again, must be “no.”

3. Does the privacy act cover inadvertent and unconsented recordings?

The third question raised is the most diversionary: Both the trial court and the COA II agreed that consent was never present. The COA II decided as a matter of common sense (I.I, page 4, FN3). The trial court decided consent was never present in order to proffer lack of the very applicability to the privacy law by means of denying private or conversation status that they now clamor to establish. The State has asked the WA Supreme Court to deliberate about interpretation of intent, a status they have vehemently denied im primis. Does the court allow such a shifting stance? It’s a diversion for fraud committed with scienier over a four-year period. The answer must be “no.”

The Court of Appeals ruled the owner of the phone violated the privacy act. It was necessary to establish the requisite entity, a “recorder”, responsible for a “recording”.

Contrary to the State's petition for discretionary review, the privacy act does not mandate intentional interception, such as wiretapping, in order to result in a protected recording. On the contrary, the language is inclusive of any divulging of any "private", recorded message, which logically mandates a recorder. It is without regard as to whether the recorder is benevolent or malevolent, oblivious or innocuous.

In their most recent request to keep after the poisonous fruit, the State infers the recording is nothing more than a recording of a physical altercation. However, the recording itself (illegitimate as it is) verifies there is a conversation in which the Autistic male (RP, 3A, 675, 9-11) is desperately trying to locate his phone which the severely intoxicated female had hidden from him. This self-evident fact must be included in the framing and analysis of this event. The Court of Appeals II made this analysis and ruled accurately within at least the fraud-less scope.

With respect to the supplemental (*Amicus Curiae*) submittal in support of this reconsideration, the respondent's arguments remain consistent.

A. Due process shortfall

How ironic is it that the call is for "a meaningful opportunity to be heard" when, for four years, the cry of justice has been fraudulently

stifled? In their epitome of adversarial and malicious literal manufacturing of a conviction, is it not surreal that parties in scienter call for “Adversarial Justice”?

In their igneus fatui request to keep the topic of “consent” afloat, the State’s lone ally, the City of Auburn, disregards two key factors: 1) Consent was the core abrogation by the trial court when it judged “inadvertency” as their means of invalidating the “communication”. This error enabled the State to remove the idea of “consent” from the domain of the privacy act, and 2) How can the topic of “consent” be sua sponte by the COA II when “consent” is seminal to the definition of the law itself?

Inadvertency implies non-consent. This was at the heart of the trial court’s decision. No relief was reaped due to the Respondent’s violation. Rather, the identification of a “recorder” of a “recording” was made by the COA II. It is a simple conclusion of logic. The voice recording is not admissible as evidence per RCW 9.73.050.

The Court of Appeals decision addressed all tenants of RCW 9.73. Whereas, the trial court ruled that the inadvertency of the recording absolved the Respondent from protection of the privacy act. The complete elemental facts of inadvertency do not justify the admissibility of the recording into evidence.

B. Sui Generis claim

Comparison of the other Smith case (1975) involving a murder by purposeful gunshot is an absurd obfuscation. This case is absolutely sui generis as determined by the COA II. There is no deviation from prior rule, but a sensible analysis worthy of affirmation. The voice recording in this case (again, even if real) is a conversation. The female is severely intoxicated. The male refers to his primary quest to locate his phone a dozen times so he can leave the chaos. The woman's only confirmed injury, a self-inflicted cut lip, was already present. There are no sounds of a beating, choking or "inflicting injury", as opposed to gunshots and a death (RP, 3B, 839, 4-19) in the State v David Smith case (1975). Christensen affirms a communication, and Kipp confirms its privacy.

The Respondent never relinquished his expectation of privacy over this private conversation in his private home. The purpose of the communication and the call itself was to find the iPhone that would remedy the privacy violation that preceded the call. This is entirely different scenario than the 1975 David Smith murder case, and sui generis was correctly pursued by the Court of Appeals

C. Substantial public interest

On this, all parties agree. But how much more important is the manufacturing of evidence to obtain a wrongful conviction based on the

mischaracterized intent of an Autistic man when confronted by a hysterically drunk woman who startled him awake in their home? How much more substantial is the public interest that police log into evidence, his iPhone, 38 minutes prior to the creation of the recorded event?

Is it not extraordinarily dangerous to the public in an ostensibly free society when the government tasked with protecting its human rights not only steals private, protected property but then uses it to fabricate a crime, to wantonly convict, and then obdurately obfuscate facts for four years in order to masquerade a false and untenable incarceration? This is of dire public concern.

How savage an attack on liberty?

The documented plethora of notices given and filings made over the four-year period, as reflected herein, serve as indomitable testimony to the State's igneus fatui version: Without the fraudulent inception of the alleged recording itself, the debate over the privacy law would be irrelevant. This entire case is "falsus in uno prima, falsus in omnibus", false in the primary thing, therefore false in everything. It is "void ab initio" as verified by just this voice recording herein.

V.

Statement of the case

On Sunday night, June 2nd, 2013 at approximately 11:11 PM, an Autistic man (RP, 3A, 675, 9-11) fled the scene of domestic chaos created

by his severely intoxicated wife (.0194 BAC at 12:21 AM, RP, 3B, 838, 12-17). This drunk woman had been screaming and cursing at him from the time she startled him awake at approx. 10:54 PM.

The mobile phone, his private, corporate cellular phone, had been logged into Vancouver Police Department evidence 38 minutes before his fourth and final attempt that 'went through to voicemail'. During that six-minute span from 11:01 – 11:07 PM, the person in possession of Respondent's iPhone returned two of those calls.

No weapons were involved, no life-threatening injury was ever sustained (RP, 3A, 698, 2-6 and RP, 2B, 468, 5-12), no indication of injury were evident on the man's hands (RP, 3B, 891, 9-13, and evidence exhibits number 51 and number 52), and no medical records or licensed physician testimony of any kind, ever supported claims of choking, neck trauma, or comatose symptoms (SAG exhibits number 1, 2, 3, 4 and 7, and RP, 3B, 836, 11-14). The man was later convicted of Second Degree Attempted Murder based solely upon a voice message allegedly extracted from the iPhone he attempted to locate during the incident.

[Note: Serious medical fraud is the subject of prior and future filings, but is omitted herein due to topical limitation to the voice recording, inadmissibility, and illegitimacy.]

The debate over the minutia of the privacy act in this case is a red herring. It has deflected attention from the extensive fraud that happened the night June 2nd, 2013, and before. It has continued unabated four years later. These crimes involving a “protected device” under 18 USC 1030, the cellular phone at the center of this case, are irrefutable, and reached their nadir with this wrongful conviction based on the voice recording that trial records and subsequent files indicate is dubious. Forensic analysis has proved the voicemail recording was digitally synthesized. The phone itself was last logged out of VPD custody on 7/15/2013 at 12:14 PM, and has never been reproduced back into evidence (in violation of ER, title 10, section 1002, 1003). Multiple varying audio recordings were questioned at trial and multiple times since, but to no avail. The State’s witness regarding authenticity of the recording had committed numerous counts of perjury during the 3-day trial. She claimed the recording’s originality, and lied about having Cellebrite certification and training, required to conduct the extraction and production of compact disc recordings. Two of the three most incriminating proofs of fraud and scienter are actual VPD records themselves, all provided in prior appeal filings regarding the iPhone and the recording, and exhibited herein.

VI.

Argument why this review and this entire case itself should be fully dismissed without delay

The flagrant nature of the fabrication of evidence used to charge and convict the respondent of Assault II and Attempted Murder II was fully exposed post-conviction. This response brief will leave no allowance for any other action than to call into question all evidence related to the case, and total vitiation of it.

The records and evidences that have been provided over several years (and are concentrated herein on the voice recording alone) verify compliance with all nine of the requisite elements to prove fraud described in Webster v. Romano 178, Wash 118, 120 (1934); namely 1) a present REPRESENTATION as a fact, 2) its MATERIALITY, 3) its FALSITY, 4) the presenter's knowledge of its falsity (SCIENTER), 5) the presenter's INTENT that it should be acted on, 6) the other party's IGNORANCE of its falsity, 7) other party's RELIANCE on the assumed truth of the representation, 8) the other party's right to RELY on it, 9) consequent DAMAGES.

The following are three salient points that prove fraud was committed upon the court. Specifically, the voice recording that is the only subject of this review.

1. The private iPhone from which the voice recording was abstracted was entered into evidence the VPD 38 minutes prior to the creation of the recording of the alleged incident.

Exhibit 1, VPD chain of custody report. It was previously submitted to the COA II within a SAG and the CrR 7.8 motion [48403-0-II]. It demonstrates two distinct data points laced with intrinsic fraud and misrepresentation.

a. The phone was logged into custody at 10:31:52 on 6/2/13, 38 minutes prior to the time of the recorded phone call (per Verizon record and VPD call log report, Exhibit 2)

b. The phone was last checked out on 7/15/13 at 12:14 PM, and has never been reproduced. This failure is contrary to the most basic tenants of rules of evidence in Title 10, sections 1002 and 1003.

2. The iPhone was accessed without a warrant, minutes before and after the incident and throughout the next morning.

Exhibit 3 contains excerpts from an astonishing total of 7,259 pages from the VPD's own extraction report. It shows show unequivocal evidence that the iPhone was invaded, its settings tampered with, and configurations modified as early as within seven minutes of the incident.

Most alarming is the erasure of the phone's GPS location history (GYRO file) that occurred at 3:55:44 AM on 6/3/13, less than five hours after the incident. Aside from clearly unlawful search, why was the Vancouver Police Department in such a hurry to delete these records?

3. The alleged recording is a digitally synthesized composite fake.

Exhibit 4 contains an email notice sent to the Clark County Prosecuting Attorney the morning of day 2 of the trial. This email notified the CCPAO that there were suspicious discrepancies in the versions of the recording played before the trial court that were alleged to have been “original” per the testimony (RP 1, 69, 21; 2A, 206, 21) of the VPD Detective who also said she was Cellebrite certified (RP 1, 72, 2; see also the identical claim on line 3, page 1, Exhibit 2).

These outright lies established from the beginning of the tainted trial, the misleading deception about the audio evidence is proven to be fraudulent in exhibit 5. The expert forensic analysis describes in detail the rampant digital fraud.

The recording is neither authentic nor legitimate. In light of this evidence of foul play and fraud to get a conviction, the ensuing conviction is fraudulent, and because it is fraudulent, it is nullified in vitiating: “A judgment that is fraudulently procured is void.” (Wilson v. Henckle).

“A void judgment is one that from its inception was a complete nullity” (Lubben). This fraud is both ACTUAL (intentional criminal deception) and CONSTRUCTIVE (words, acts, or omissions that tend to mislead or deceive) [Black’s 10th, and, per US v. Frock Morton] “there is no question of the general doctrine that fraud vitiates... even judgments...

fraud vitiates everything.” Furthermore, these deceptions cannot be deemed collateral matters and must be considered paramount to vitiate this case (reference WI State v. Fankhouser).

VII.
Summary of Fraud

“It is a well settled principal of law that the party attempting to admit a... recording into evidence must prove, by clear and convincing evidence, that “it is a true, accurate and authentic recording” (US v. Blakey).

In this case, what do we have?

- A. Perjury by the State’s witness and lead detective regarding her certification and authenticity of at least four different versions of the original recording(s) and their transcript(s)
- B. Ignorance of notice by the Prosecuting Attorney regarding signs of tampering at the time of trial
- C. Failure to follow Chain of Custody rules and procedures
incriminate and reveal
 - 1. the iPhone was seized before the time of the incident, and
 - 2. the same iPhone was logged out 17 months before trial
and has never been reproduced

3. Evidence shows extensive tampering within minutes of the alleged incident, including the erasure of GPS tracking data, actions indicative of attempts to cover up the pre-incident theft, and pre-planned staging of a crime that never occurred.
4. Expert forensic analysis based on State of the Art spectrum and weigh form acoustic analysis of the recording verifies there was recording was tampered and falsified, including obscuration (masking), transformation (rearranging), synthesis (artificial adding and impersonation), gaps (inexplicable changes), transients (clicks and pops indicative of splicing), and even background sounds of the recording being fabricated.

All parties now know that the initial suspect nature of the audio recording is confirmed by the State's own evidence used to wrongfully convict, to be a highly purposeful, yet amateur falsification. The bad actors were too incompetent to cover up all of their tracks that VPD records, at least in part, tells the true story. Expert acoustic analysis hammers down the final nail in the coffin of the brutal fraud with scienter intent to convict the Respondent. This fraud has been laced with vitriol and avarice. It is morally stunning and judicially corrupt.

Sadly, however, it has been common place in Clark County and Vancouver, WA where law enforcement operates with an “astonishing” policy that the police are free to “hoke up” a case to make sure there is conviction, and that “there is no violation of the Constitution if evidence is fabricated” (Spencer v. Krause, 2017). The Honorable Judge Hurwitz said it best, and said it all, in response, “Wow!”

What else can be said when the police and the courts so brashly stoop to this level?

If preservation of life, liberty and property still matters in Washington and in these United States, and if the US Constitution’s Fourth and Fourteenth Amendments, and Article 1, section 7 and 10 of the Washington Constitution are still relevant, then the Washington Supreme Court must rule without delay to vitiate this lawless case in its decedent entirety.

VII. Conclusion

This debate over privacy law semantics is an igneus fatui diversion designed and implemented to cover up the intrinsic fraud upon this court, the citizens of Washington, and upon the Respondent and his dependents.

Even so, the privacy law remains exceedingly clear: Divulgement of any private communication without consent is unlawful. State v.

Christensen alone affirms the Court of Appeals simple reversal based on the universal protection of private cellular phones. Society's "Overton Window" strictly does NOT open free reign into the ubiquitous hand-held technology. Constitutional law absolutely does not condone the raw fraud committed here.

The State has created confusion where there is none: At face value, notwithstanding the insipient fraud whose concealment continues to be the State's motivation to limit liability, a private conversation was recorded on a private communication device and divulged without consent, so it is inadmissible on all three structural legs of the privacy law. Illegitimacy is not even allowed into the debate over inadmissibility, which is why the entire review is so diversionary.

Now, the Prosecution persists in trying to stoke the flames of the igneus fatui with the rekindling of inadvertency. But inadvertency is not flammable because it is not in the law. Fraud, on the other hand, has finally been set ablaze with the torch of truth.

The State's arguments sound sublime, but they are actually very dark, because they are crafted to hide truth, to deceive. But the secret things that were hidden in darkness are now brought to light, and the secret aims and motives are now exposed.

Fortunately, the simple precedent for the only honorable response was set nearly 140 years ago in Throckmorton's Razor: "Fraud vitiates everything."

was not injured during the crash and he never mentioned any lingering effects from the crash. Sheryl did mention that once off the bike, Garrett actually punched the dog that was chasing them. Sheryl also explained that Garrett is a very athletic person, rides a bike and runs often, and even participated in an Ironman Triathlon in Canada in 2010.

I then asked Sheryl about the PO Box at 13215 SE Mill Plain Rd. where she has received the letters from Garret since his arrest. Sheryl clarified that she has had that PO Box since June 2007 and that she is the only one with a key to it. She added that occasionally Skylar or Jordan may access it on her behalf but that no one else retrieved mail at this address. I asked Sheryl if Garrett was aware of who has access to the box and she said he knows if mail goes there, she will be the one receiving it. Sheryl turned over numerous letters to me in this interview to include the envelopes. This aspect will be documented in an additional supplemental report. I did ask Sheryl how receiving the letters made her feel. Sheryl began to cry and said that she feels that Garrett is harassing her and trying to get her to support him in this case, despite what he did to her. She said the letters make her afraid and that she absolutely does not want contact with Garrett in any way.

I spoke to Sheryl about her and Garrett's connection with Steven Hanson, explaining that she was mistaken about his first name being Scott. Sheryl stated that yes, Steven was his first name and that she did make a mistake when she said Scott. She then said he works for Back In Motion Chiropractic prior to me mentioning the name of this business. I confirmed this was the information I had developed. Sheryl then explained that Steven attended her and Garrett's wedding and they considered him a friend. Steven and Garrett were both members of a running club called the Red Lizards and she and Garrett sought chiropractic care from him/his office. Sheryl then explained that when Steven initially called her he mentioned that he was going to assist Garrett and her and help find him an attorney; obviously Steven believed that Sheryl was in support of Garrett and he was not aware of the full scope of what happened. Sheryl explained to him what took place and once he had this knowledge and the knowledge of the no contact order the conversation was ended. From my contact with Steven's office it is clear that Steven is not in support of Garrett and has no plans to assist him in any way.

The interview continued and I asked Sheryl about her knowledge of Garrett's drinking and how much/often he drank. Sheryl explained that Garrett was not one to come home drunk, but that he did drink on occasion. I asked if Garrett ever drank to the point of passing out or blacking out. Sheryl said he absolutely did not. I asked Sheryl if Garrett has ever displayed any strange or odd behaviors that would suggest he was under the influence of any mind altering substance and she said he has not. Sheryl clarified that to her knowledge Garrett has never experienced blackouts of any kind for any reason.

Due to the length of the interview I concluded my questions, explaining that perhaps at a later time I would need to interview her further and would arrange that through Mr. Walker. Sheryl stated that was fine and she was willing to cooperate with this investigation in any way she could. I directed Sheryl to retain any additional letters she might receive from Garrett so that I could get them and she stated she would. I then concluded this interview with Sheryl.

On 07/15/13 I authored and received a search warrant signed by the Honorable Judge Osler to search the contents of Garrett's phone that was retained at the scene by Ofc. Yong. Once the warrant was signed I went to the VPD Evidence Facility and obtained the phone, evidence item number 1455-002, from evidence personnel. I then immediately took the phone to VPD West Precinct and met with DECU forensic specialist Robert Barnes. Robert assisted me by allowing me access to the "Faraday box". I placed the phone into the Faraday box, sealed the box and plugged the phone into a charging cord. The faraday box is a device used to prohibit any radio waves from reaching the phone once it is turned on. I placed the phone into the box to ensure that if any commands were sent to the phone to wipe the contents, the command would not be successful. Once I turned the phone on I learned it did not need a passcode or PIN of any kind to access it. I opened the phone to the settings function and placed it into "airplane mode" as well as turned off the Wi-Fi access. Once this was completed I was able to

remove the phone from the box without risk of losing the data on the phone.

I then returned to my office and attempted to complete a download of the phone using the Cellebrite UFED (Universal Forensic Extraction Device) as I am certified to use this equipment. I continued to run into problems and errors with this equipment and was not able to access the phone in this manner. I then returned to VPD West Precinct and was assisted again by Robert Barnes. Robert agreed to process the phone by using the Cellebrite Physical Analyzer software on his laptop computer. I provided Robert a copy of the search warrant and he proceeded to process the phone. Due to the large amount of information on the phone, Robert placed the report onto a thumb drive because it would not fit on a CD or DVD. The processing of the phone was completed on 07/16/13 and I obtained the phone, report and thumb drive from Robert on that date.

I then placed the information from the thumb drive on the hard drive of my assigned work computer and also placed the report in PDF format onto a CD. This CD was retained in temporary evidence until it could be properly packaged and placed into the VPD Evidence System. I reviewed the report and the phone information was documented as having an Apple ID of jgspe@me.com, phone number 503.203.2695, and serial number C39FCX2MDDP9. Through listening to jail phone calls placed by Garrett, I know he often uses the address of jgspe@me.com and also that "jgspe" stands for "John Garrett Smith professional engineer". The report also documents that the phone number 503.203.2695 is labeled as "Garrett Smith"; further confirming that this is indeed the phone used by and belonging to John Garrett Smith.

I also physically looked at the phone, took photos of several screens to document missed calls, placed calls, voice mail messages and text messages. These photos are uploaded into this report under the image tab. I then created a time line of activity on Garrett's phone for the night of the incident on 6/2/13-6/3/13. This activity is listed as follows: (I was able to establish that the contact listed in Garrett's phone as "Polygentech" is the home landline number 808-238-8471 at 14607 SE Rivershore Dr., Vancouver, WA. This is a Hawaii phone number but the Smith's were able to use it as a landline through services provided by Verizon.)

As I processed the phone I accessed the voicemail section and located what I believed to be the recording of the altercation under the voicemail listed "Polygentech". I played the voicemail and put it on speaker. The sound quality was not perfect but I was surprised at how much I could hear and hear clearly, to include both a male and female's voice. From the totality of my investigation it is clear that the male on the recording is Garrett and the female is Sheryl. I listened to the recording several times, both through the phone and then through the downloaded file retrieved after the warrant was served on the phone, throughout this investigation. It was clear to me that at a minimum, Garrett did not know his actions and words were being recorded.

The conversation begins with an argument in which it appears Garrett is suggesting that Sheryl is having an affair, possibly with a Hispanic person. At one point in the recording Sheryl can be heard referring to the male by name as "Garrett" and she asks him to stop and tells him to get away. Garret says "no way". Garrett then can be heard saying "I will kill you". Sheryl responds by saying "I know" and then Garrett says what sounds like 'Bitch, you wanna kill me?' Then Garrett yells "Give me back my phone". Sheryl responds by saying "No, leave me alone" and then she begins to yell for "Zoe" who I learned was her dog. Garrett then asks where his phone is and Sheryl states "look what you did to me" in a voice that sounded different from her previous statements. Sheryl continues to yell for Zoe. Garrett tells Sheryl to give him his phone and he'll leave. Sheryl says again "look what you did to me" at least twice more. There's additional loud screaming by Sheryl and Garrett continues to ask for his phone. Garrett then calls Sheryl a "fucking bitch" and says "I got your ass". Sheryl continues to scream and Garrett mentions that he "found the money to get us through and you had to go do this". Sheryl screams once more and then there are a few seconds of silence. Garrett then makes a statement that sounded to me like 'I think she stopped breathing' but then Sheryl begins to scream again and Garrett asks her where the phone is. Sheryl


