Appellant/Cross-Respondent hereby submits his reply brief to Brief of Respondent-Cross Appellant Michelle McGehee pursuant to RAP 10.2(d).

To reiterate one of the main issues argued in the Brief of Appellant, allowing the Redmond Initiative No. 1 to be transmitted will have extensive political effects regardless of the initiative's potential legal effect. The initiative is a valid expression of political speech. A public vote on the Redmond Initiative No. 1 will prompt public debate and public discussion.

Permitting the City of Redmond to stop the Redmond Initiative No. 1 before the signature-counting phase will cause irremediable harm to the Redmond Initiative process as a whole. Should the City of Redmond succeed in preventing the initiative to be on the ballot at the early stage of signature-validation, it will deter future citizens from exercising their right to political expression by way of initiative. This will harm both the City of Redmond and its citizens.


