## Statement of Additional Circumstances:

The gun used in my trial from the California conviction was suppose to have been suppressed from the suppression motion I presented to the courts during trial because it was highly prejudicial and played a key role in my <sup>false</sup> conviction.

The State never proved or showed any type of connection to the gun from the California conviction and the first degree robbery in Seattle, Washington. In fact the State never proved that the gun was ever in the State of Washington. At pre-trial prosecutor Ferral stated that they couldn't find the origin of the gun but Officer Martin of the California Police Department stated that he connected the serial number of the gun at trial to the serial number to the gun that they arrested me with in California to make out that it was the same gun from California.

The gun was in Washington's possession since April 2011 the first and only time any witness got a chance to see the gun was Oct 2, 2011; after trial had already started. Ms. Deloris Majores was the first person, witness and also victim; that got to see the gun and she said that the gun was different. Javonna Williams a witness and also participant in the robbery of Ms. Majores said; not that it was the gun but; "it looked like that".
