AGREEMENT REGARDING
DISCIPLINE

The Washington Certified Professional Guardian Board (Board) and Thomas P. Robinson, CPG No. 5788, for himself and on behalf of Robinson Guardianship Services, CPGA No. 5788, (Respondents), do hereby stipulate and enter into this Agreement Regarding Discipline, pursuant to the Board's Disciplinary Regulations for Certified Professional Guardians (DR), as follows:

1. The Washington State Supreme Court approved Thomas P. Robinson as a Certified Professional Guardian (CPG), effective April 13, 2001. His Certified Professional Guardian number is 4756.

2. Mr. Robinson operates a certified professional guardianship agency, known as Robinson Guardian Services, P.S. (Agency). The Washington State Supreme Court approved the Agency as a Certified Professional Guardian Agency, effective April 13, 2001. The Agency's Certified Professional Guardian Agency number is 5788.

3. In June, 2002, the Board appointed a Review Panel to investigate a complaint filed against Mr. Robinson. After review it became apparent that Mr. Robinson was the principal guardian responsible for the subject cases of the Agency, and that his actions in the cases also constituted those of the Agency. Accordingly, this stipulation covers the acts of both Mr. Robinson personally and the Agency.

4. The Review Panel has completed its investigation in this matter and recommends that the Board enter into an Agreement Regarding Discipline with the Respondent, pursuant to Disciplinary Regulation V.

5. The Review Panel shall continue its investigation and review of this matter for a period of six months from the date this Agreement is signed by the Board. At the conclusion of this time period, the Panel shall contact the Respondents and the Spokane County Superior Court to verify the compliance of Mr. Robinson and the Agency with

1 the reporting requirements of the guardianship statutes and orders of the court pertaining
2 to the Respondent and the Agency's management of its caseload.

3 6. If no further or ongoing problems of a significant nature related to the oath, duties or
4 standards of practice for certified professional guardians are reported to the Panel at that
5 time, this disciplinary case shall be closed with a written admonition from the Board to
6 the Respondents. The admonition shall contain the material facts relating to the
particular acts and omissions of the Respondents that are the basis for this Agreement
Regarding Discipline, as set forth in the Stipulated Findings Regarding Discipline
entered into by the Board and the Respondents.

7 7. If further or ongoing problems of a significant nature related to the oath, duties or
8 standards of practice for certified professional guardians are reported to the Panel during
9 or at the conclusion of this six-month period, the investigation and review of this case
shall be reopened and the Review Panel shall proceed according to the Disciplinary
Regulations of the Board.

10 8. This Agreement shall be retained by the Administrative Office of the Courts in the
11 Respondents' disciplinary files. Notice of any discipline imposed shall be published in
12 accord with DR V.C., which requires that the Board send notice of the discipline
imposed to all superior courts in the State of Washington.

13 9. Respondents have no prior record of discipline as certified professional guardians.

14 10. This Agreement Regarding Discipline is binding as a statement of all known facts
15 relating to the conduct of the Respondents, but any additional existing acts may be
proven in any subsequent disciplinary proceeding.

16 11. Respondents shall not owe any costs, restitution or expenses as a result of this
17 disciplinary proceeding.

18 12. By their signatures affixed hereto, the Respondents enter into this Agreement freely
and voluntarily, having been advised of the right to counsel at their own expense.
