

## Guardianship Program Rules

### 702 Definitions

702.1 "Agency" means any legal entity in the State of Washington authorized by its formation documents to act as a fiduciary, guardian, or limited guardian. (Revised 3-8-10).

702.2 "Designated CPG" means the certified professional guardians within an agency who have the final decision-making authority for incapacitated persons or their estate on behalf of the agency. (Revised 4-13-15)

702.3 "Fees and Filing Requirements Table" refers to the listing of Board-approved fees for the various CPG and agency application and reporting requirements identified in these Regulations. 702.4 "GR 23" refers to Washington State Court General Rule 23 which establishes the scope and authority of the CPG Board, minimal qualifications for guardian and agency applicants, and mandatory ongoing guardian and agency disclosure requirements.
