COMES NOW, Respondents, by and through their attorney of record, Patrick McMahon, of Carlson & McMahon, PLLC, and hereby submits this Objection to Appellant's Motion to Allow Evidence.

I. FACTS

The superior court in this matter dismissed the Plaintiff's Complaint following a Summary Judgment Motion. The Summary Judgment dismissal was based upon the Plaintiff receiving two (2) voluntary non-suits pursuant to CR 41 in prior litigation. The Plaintiff had already had a prior dismissal with prejudice of all of the causes of action outlined in the Complaint. The Plaintiff has appealed the Summary Judgment Motion. The Court of Appeals affirmed the dismissal.

II. ARGUMENT

The Appellant in this matter continues to ignore the legal basis of the dismissal of the underlying cause of action and continues to attempt to argue factual issues for trial. There is no basis for this court to grant Plaintiff's Motion to allow further evidence. "On review of an order for summary judgment, we performed the same inquiry as the trial court and we 'consider only evidence and issues called to the attention of the trial court." Gatner, Inc. v. Dep't of Revenue, 11 Wn.App.2d 765, 777 (2020), citing RAP 9.12 and Solvay Chems., Inc. v. Dep't of Revenue, 4 Wn.App.2d 918, 922 (2018). In this case, the evidence considered by the

superior court is currently before this court. (See Clerk's Papers). The Plaintiff has offered no justifiable basis to expand the record on appeal to include any further factual evidence. Moreover, the Plaintiff has yet to identify what additional factual evidence he is seeking to add to the record on appeal, or how the additional evidence has any relevance to the current appeal.

III. CONCLUSION

Since the factual evidence considered by the superior court is currently before this court, there is no basis to justify adding evidence to the appellate record. As such, this court should deny the Appellant's request for additional evidence, especially given that he has failed to identify the specific evidence he wishes to add to the appellate record.
