Plaintiff's Motion to Enlarge the Time to File

Petition for Discretionary Review

Facts

However, in concurring with his colleagues, the Honorable Leonard J. Feldman raise an issue (among other things) of substantial public interest that should be determined by the Supreme

"Here, for example, El Gamia could potentially argue that a reasonably carefully person in the same or similar circumstances would take precautions (such as closing the door) to protect property entrants from being rushed by large pets. Whether to adopt such a test in place of the traditional common law duties owed by an owner or occupier of land is an issue that should be determined by our Supreme Court."

With this observation, I respectfully concur:

Justice Feldman concurring opinion at p.3.
