STATEMENT OF FINANCES

I, **Mary Fung Koehler, Petitioner/ Plaintiff, Pro Se**, certify that I cannot afford to pay the \$200 filing fee normally required to file a petition for review.

1. I request that the filing fee be waived and that I be allowed to file a petition for review without prepayment of the filing fee.
2. My request for additional appellate review in this case is brought in good faith.
3. I am not employed. I receive social security retirement benefits of \$767.00 per month after Medicare payments are deducted. I also receive Medicaid and some food stamps.
4. I only have a checking account in a financial institution. The total amount of funds I have in the account is \$123.84.
5. In the past 12 months I did not receive any interest, dividends, rental payments. I did sell stock in the amount of \$354.98 to help pay for car

insurance. The total amount of cash I received was \$450.00. The total amount of cash I have other than otherwise indicated is \$40.
