I understand the Court will review this Statement of Additional Grounds for Review when my appeal is considered on the merits.

Additional Ground 1

Dismiss Count "1" murder in the first degree for LACK of A SUFFICIENT CASE. A LEGAL ARGUMENT made in pretrial motion that the statute upon which the crime is based is unconstitutionally VAGUE.

"I HAVE two Grounds, they are both premised on the element of premeditation."

Additional Ground 2

Dismiss on Factual Grounds Count 1 murder in the first "premeditation" the state now having rested I believe that premeditation requires more than amount of deliberation I don't believe the state has shown that. The state should have granted the motion on JANUARY 26th 2012.
