

STATEMENT OF ADDITIONAL
GROUNDS FOR REVIEW

I, Shellye L. Stark, have received and reviewed the opening brief prepared by my attorney, Jill S. Reuter. Summarized below are the additional grounds for review that are not addressed in that brief. I understand the Court will review this Statement of Additional Grounds for Review when my appeal is considered on the merits.

Regarding the second argument made in my opening brief, I wish the court to consider the aspect that the State's key witness, Detective Kip Hollenbeck, gave impermissible opinion testimony during my trial as a live witness, thusly impacting the jury's ability to discern fact from opinion, ^{and} ~~as~~ the statement goes to my credibility at the time of the interrogation as well as my credibility at the time of my own live testimony. The inference could have been made by the jury that if I fabricated statements in my interrogation, I am once again fabricating said statements as a live witness in front of the jury.
