submits this supplemental authority regarding her Petition for Review:

In re Yung-Cheng Tsai, __ Wn.2d __, __ P.3d __ (May 7, 2015) (2015 WL 2164187) (holding that, “[a]s applied to Washington, the holding in Padilla v. Kentucky, 559 U.S. 356, 130 S. Ct. 1473, 176 L.Ed.2d 284 (2010),” did not announce a new rule but “did effect a significant change in the law” which applies retroactively, because it was always ineffective assistance of counsel to fail to be aware of and properly advise a client about the immigration consequences of a plea in a criminal case but Washington state cases had previously indicated that counsel was not so ineffective unless there was an affirmative misrepresentation of the plea’s immigration consequences).
