I, Geron Lee Harrison, the appellant, summarizes below and further states additional grounds for review that have not been addressed thus far. I understand that the Court will review this Statement of Additional Grounds for Review and consider it on its merits.

Additional Grounds One:

Judge Ronald Kessler of the State of Washington King County Superior Court in Seattle, Washington, in the lower court action in the above cited appeal regarding both appellant's and appellee's Dissolution of Marriage and Child Custody case, court ordered on or about May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2014, that the appellant was court ordered to have supervised visitations of his four children, which supervision fees would cost about \$400.00 per month (or \$50.00 per hour), which was more than the appellant's initial court ordered Child Support, which was court ordered by the



court at about \$200.00 per month for all four of his children, which is twice as much of appellant's court ordered child support, which created an unfair and undue hardship for the appellant to have his parental visitations with his four children. The appellant, Geron Lee Harrison, on the court record during his trial, contested these facts and court actions as unfair and would create an undue financial hardship for the appellant, who was indigent and receiving Food Stamps at the time, and is still financially under the 125% percentile of the federal poverty guidelines, but the court refused to further evaluate and consider these mitigating factors to rule upon, knowing fully, that appellant could not afford to pay his supervision fees for his court ordered supervised visits, while simultaneously paying his court ordered child support, thus preventing and thwarting appellant from continuing and renewing his natural and parental relationship with his children, which has created a *de facto* loss of parental rights situation for the appellant, which has federal and state constitutional ramifications.

If there are additional grounds, additional statements and summaries will be submitted and filed with this statement.
