A. Identity of Moving Party

Respondent/Petitioner, State of Washington, by and through Kimberly A.

Thulin, Appellate Deputy Prosecutor for Whatcom County, requests the relief designated in Part B.

B. Statement of Relief Sought

Counsel seeks a one day extension to November 17th, 2016 to file the State's Petition for Review.



C. Facts Relevant to Motion

The Court of Appeals decision in this case was issued on October 17, 2016. The State filed its Petition for Review yesterday, November 17th and was informed today that the petition was filed one day late.

Counsel for Respondent initially was planning on filing a Motion for Reconsideration with the Court of Appeals. RAP 18.8(a) allows the Court to alter the provisions of RAP 10.2(c) and enlarge the time within which an act must be done in order to serve the ends of justice. Based on these rules Respondent/Petitioner asks this Court to grant a one day extension for filing of the State's Petition for Review.
