I, Luis Lomez Esteban, have received and reviewed the opening brief prepared by my attorney. Summarized below are the additional grounds for review that are not addressed in that brief. I understand the Court will review this Statement of Additional Grounds for Review when my appeal is considered on the merits.

Additional Ground 1

one of the errors in my trial was that they did not take in to account the statements of the nurse at the hospital. She checked the victim (that the state brought to my trial) and showed I didn't have sex with the victim. The family of the victim accuses me of having intercourse with the victim; however the nurse clearly testified that the tests indicate that there is no evidence to prove I had sex with the victim. I don't believe the jury had sufficient evidence to hold that I was guilty, and therefore this conviction should be reversed.

Additional Ground 2

Another ground for reversal is that my court appointed attorney was ineffective. My attorney was never ready for my hearings. Several times, my attorney would not even show up for my hearings and the judge would have to reschedule. I petitioned the judge to give me another attorney because my attorney was not helping me at all; however, this petition was denied. When my attorney finally showed up to trial, I was asking him what was going on, but he just ignored me and never answered any of my questions.

The jury got tired and finally changed their mind to give the court its way.

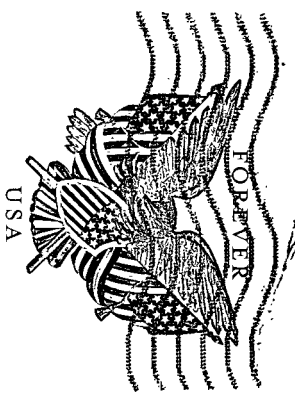
